- II. Production Research
- III. Market Alternatives

All three are equal in priority.

I. Utilization - not ranked as to priorities

- a. Edible soybeans
- b. Aquaculture
- c. Meal-oil
- d. Other market potential uses or market avenues
- e. Health benefits

II. Production Research

- a. Variety development and trials
 1. Nematode resistance
 2. Oil - high content - low saturated fat
 3. Protein - high content
 4. Yield
- b. Nematodes - race identification and control
- c. Economical weed control
 1. Includes low rate chemical controls
 2. Glyphosate resistant weeds
- d. Pesticide trials

1. Spider Mites
2. Stink Bugs
 - e. Bio-pest control
 - f. Drought management
 1. Irrigation
 2. Cover Crop
 - g. Deer damage control management (work with other states)
 - h. Population
 - i. Soybean Aphid
 - j. Soybean Rust
 - k. Seed/Grain Quality
- l. Salt Tolerant Soybean Varieties
 - m. Other

A combination of two or more of the above under best management.
